- Drop-off events are for Lexington County residents only.
- Material generated by businesses will **not** be accepted. Businesses may bring recyclables to the Edmund Landfill.
- Volunteers will be on site to help unload recyclables from vehicles as residents drive through the parking lot and stop at drop-off stations.
- Refrigerators and other appliances with Freon are **not** accepted at events but may be brought to the Edmund Landfill for a fee of \$15 per unit.
- In the event of excessive turnout, the end of the line may be designated prior to the event end time to allow cars time to get through each drop-off station by 1 p.m.

Materials Accepted

Electronics

No large appliances!



Computers, printers, TVs, microwaves, phones, and more.
LIMIT: 8 items per household.

Paper to be Shred

Will be shredded on site.
LIMIT: 5 boxes or bags per household.



Household Hazardous Waste

Paint, aerosols, cleaning supplies, fire extinguishers, mercury, batteries.
PAINT LIMIT: 8 gallons per household.



Pesticides

Accepted from any South Carolina resident or farmer.
LIMIT: 2500 pounds solid and 300 gallons of liquids.

Shoes

Gently used, any size/kind for any age/gender.



Goodwill Donations

Clothes, furniture, and household items accepted. No electronics.
