

**Electronics** - Computers, printers, TVs, phones, stereos, and more. **LIMIT: 8** items per household.





Paper – Paper shredded immediately on site. LIMIT: 5 boxes, tubs or paper bags (any size) per household. No plastic bags. Paper clips and staples ok.



#### **Reusable Household**

**Items** - Clothes, furniture, and other household items to be reused, not recycled.

#### **Important Information:**

- Events are held rain or shine but are subject to cancellation due to COVID-19.

- This drop-off event is open to Lexington County residents only. Be prepared to show a driver's license.
- Material generated by businesses, including non-profits and landlords, is not accepted at events.
- Residents are asked to stay in their vehicles and to wear a mask to keep traffic moving safely. Volunteers will be on site to help unload material from vehicles as residents drive through the parking lot stopping at drop-off stations.
- Lexington County residents may also bring up to five large electronics to the Edmund Landfill at no charge Monday to Saturday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. A box or bag of small items counts as one and computer components all count as one.
- Household hazardous waste (e.g. paint, fire extinguishers, pesticides, bug spray) is now being collected a few times a month at select Collection and Recycling Centers. To receive the schedule, contact Traude Sander.

- In the event of excessive turnout, the end of the line may be designated prior to the event end time to allow cars time to get through each drop-off station by 1 p.m.
