WOOD WASTE, CLEAN (e.g., branches, stumps, clean lumber, pallets) Wood waste is accepted at Ball Park, Bush River, Chapin, Edmund, Sandhills and Southeast Collection and Recycling Centers.	Some	No	YES

* These items are accepted ONLY at the Edmund Landfill. Handling fees may be assessed. Call (803) 755-3325 for details.

** Loads with more than four tires and commercially generated tires are accepted ONLY at the Edmund Landfill. A handling fee will be assessed unless business shows valid ST-390.

Why is recycling important?

- Recycling prevents materials from going into a landfill.
- Recycling saves money and creates jobs.
- Recycling saves natural resources like trees and petroleum.

How should items be prepared for recycling?

- Empty and rinse all containers.
- NO plastic bags.
- Keep newspaper, magazines, cardboard and office paper clean and dry.
- Flatten cardboard and cartons only.
- Leave plastic lids on plastic bottles and metal lids on or in metal cans. Discard caps from cartons and aerosol cans. Remove nozzle from aerosol cans.
- At Lexington County Collection and Recycling Centers, place recyclables in the correct containers.
- When in doubt, leave it out ... or ask!
