Electronics (E-Waste) Accepted at Special Recycling Drop-off Events

Up to eight (8) electronic items will be accepted from each household at each drop-off event.

- ✓ Banking and financial equipment
- ✓ Cell phones (a small box or bag of cell phones will be counted as one item)
- ✓ Computers* - CPUs, laptops, mainframes, keyboards, mouse, monitors* (CRTs and flat screens), etc. (A computer set (e.g. monitor and hard drive) will be bundled to count as one item)
- ✓ Electronic circuit boards and components
- ✓ Gaming systems and equipment
- ✓ Medical equipment
- ✓ PDAs
- ✓ Printers*, copiers, fax machines, scanners (ink removed)
- ✓ Rechargeable batteries (a small box or bag of batteries will be counted as one item)
- ✓ Stereo equipment
- ✓ Televisions*



* Effective July 1, 2011, state law bans specific electronics from disposal in solid waste landfills. Residents and businesses may not place or discard **computers, computer monitors, printers or televisions** in the garbage. Electronics cannot be taken apart for the purpose of recycling. (S.C. Code of Law, 48-60-05 et seq.)

Up to five (5) electronics per day are accepted for recycling from residents and businesses at the Edmund C&D Landfill located at 498 Landfill Lane, Lexington, SC 29073, Monday to Saturday from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. There is no charge for residents, however businesses will be charged a fee of \$300 per ton (\$0.15 per pound) for e-waste material.
