

Got Electronics?

Reuse or Recycle Them!



South Carolina state law (S.C. Code of Law, 48-60-05 et seq.) bans computers, computer monitors, printers, and televisions from being placed in the garbage and solid waste landfills. Please reuse or recycle these and other electronics responsibly.

Computers, computer monitors, printers and TVs are **only** accepted by Lexington County at the Edmund Landfill and at Drop-off Events. Other, smaller, electronics may be recycled in the "scrap metal" containers (if mostly metal) at any of the 11 Collection and Recycling Centers or may be disposed of in household garbage (if mostly plastic).



At The Edmund Landfill

Lexington County residents may bring up to five (5) electronics from their primary residence to the Edmund Landfill to be recycled at no charge. All types of electronics, including CRT (box style) TVs, are accepted. Computer components are bundled to count as one and a box or bag of small items (e.g. cell phones) counts as one. Businesses may bring up to five (5) for a small fee of \$0.15/lb or contact the County Recycling Coordinator for alternatives. Stop on the scale at the landfill for instructions and be prepared to unload all items yourself. The Edmund Landfill is located at 498 Landfill Ln, Lexington, SC 29073 and is open Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (closed on Sundays).

Electronics Accepted at Drop-off Events

- Batteries
- Cell phones
- Computers
- Gaming systems/equipment
- Medical equipment
- PDAs
- Printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners (no ink)
- Stereo equipment
- Televisions (CRTs & flat screens)

At Drop-Off Events

Lexington County residents may bring up to eight (8) electronics to drop-off events held around the County each year. Computer components are bundled to count as one and a box or bag of small items (e.g. cell phones) counts as one. Go to www.lex-co.sc.gov/solidwaste for the Recycling Event schedule or contact the County Recycling Coordinator to receive email notifications prior to each event. Material from businesses is **not** accepted at events.

At Local Stores

Take electronics and cords to local stores such as Best Buy or Staples to be recycled. Staples does not accept TVs and Best Buy charges a fee for CRT TVs.



Give Them to Charitable Groups

Donate **working** electronics to charitable organizations such as His House (803-791-0557, pick-up service provided), Salvation Army (803-748-9964, pick-up service provided), or Goodwill Industries. CRT (box-style) TVs are **not** accepted by these organizations.
