**Working Paper 1 for Airport Layout Plan at Lexington County Airport at Pelion - Jim Starling, Engineering Associate III** - Mr. Randy Edwards, Public Works County Engineer, and Katherine Hubbard, County Administrator, presented the proposed Working Paper 1 for the Airport Layout Plan. Ms. Hubbard reported the Working Paper is step one in the Airport Layout Plan and Master Planning effort, and once submitted, the County can move forward with the next step in the process. Staff recommends approval of the proposed Working Paper and to direct the LPA Group and staff to submit it to the FAA for approval.
