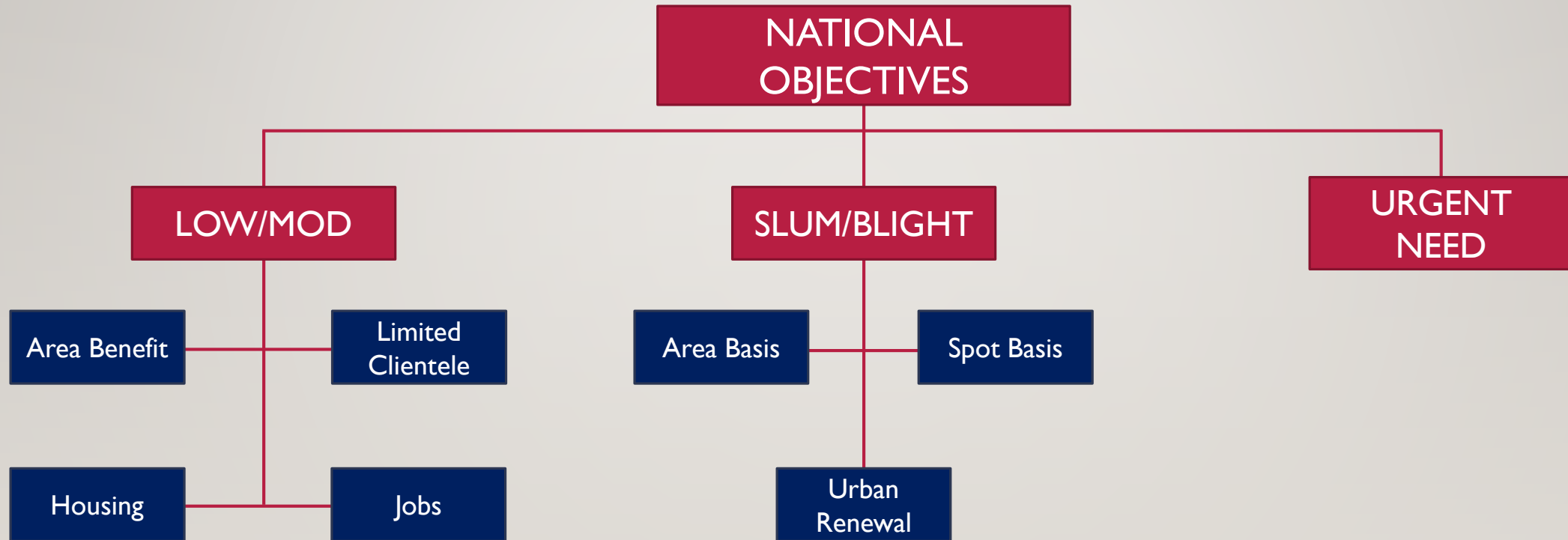
CDBG-CV OVERVIEW

Lexington County will receive a supplemental allocation to our Community Development Block Grant funds that must be used to ***prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus*** (COVID-19). This allocation was authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, which was signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020, to respond to the growing effects of this historic public health crisis. The CARES Act will provide \$1,086,200 in Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds to the County from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

OVERVIEW

- CDBG-CV can ONLY be used for eligible activities that will be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to and that are directly related to COVID-19
- CDBG-CV funds are provided to Lexington County by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on a formula basis
- Lexington County was awarded \$1,086,200 in funds
- Eligible activity must meet one of the three National Objectives
 - Benefit Low- to Moderate-Income Persons
 - Aid in the preventing or eliminating of Slum and Blight
 - Meet an Urgent Need

OVERVIEW

- Following enactment of the CARES Act, there are no percentage caps on any CDBG-CV eligible project/activity.
- Lexington County will amend their 2020-2024 Consolidated Annual Action Plan (Con Plan) to include the method of distribution of funds for each CDBG-CV activity.
- Under the CARES Act, the amendment of the Con Plan will provide a comment period of no less than 5-days.
- Projects/Activities are NOT exempt from Environmental Reviews.
