Approximately 20 documents related to the Luther Lemuel Lown family from the late 19th and early 20th centuries (donated by Neil Lown); Star pattern 20 block quilt and basket pattern quilt probably made by Bell Kaminer, ca. 1930; Star pattern quilt by unknown maker in the Kaminer/Hyler family, ca. 1930; and an unfinished yo-yo quilt comprising 17 squares and an envelope of yo-yos from the early 1930s made by Pearle Kaminer Norris (all donated by Paula Ritchie of Orlando, FL descended from the Kaminer family); 1861 yarn winder on bench from the Corley family and 15 19th century bottles (donated by Wallace Corley)
