

Drawing Mobile Home Park Site Plans

- Zoning Site Plans are not required to be drawn professionally. They may be drawn by hand using a pencil, scale or ruler and a straight edge (such as a ruler). Scales of 1" = 20', 1" = 40' and 1" = 60' are provided below. Simply print this page and cut out the scale that you wish to work with.
- Grid paper may be purchased at your local office supply store to assist you in preparing your site plan.
- If you have an extra copy of your property plat, you may use that to draw the Mobile Home Park and other site plan requirements as long as it is to scale of 1" = 20', 30', 40', 50', 60', or 100'. Please make sure that the plat you use is a true copy and has not been reduced or enlarged.
- Whether drawn professionally or by hand, all Mobile Home Park site plans must contain all of the site plan requirements as listed on the second page of the *ZONING APPLICATION FOR MOBILE HOME PARKS* and must be submitted in conjunction with the application.
- We cannot accept faxed versions of site plans since the fax transmission will not hold the original scale.
