DON'T BREAK THE LAW!

South Carolina Litter Laws 56-5-4110 and 16-11-700:

- Require all transported loads to be securely covered and/or fastened;
- Prohibit people from dumping, depositing, discarding or disposing of litter or solid waste, including cigarettes and cigarette filters, on public or private property or in water;
- Require that brush and tree limbs not drag on the road or obstruct lights or license plates when transported.

Penalties for violating these laws may include:

- Fines up to \$1,000 plus court assessments,
- Up to one year in prison,
- Confiscation of vehicles used to illegally dump large amounts of litter,
- Community service litter pick-ups.
