- Paper (all kinds – shredded, plain, newspaper)
- Plastic bottles

CVS & Walgreens (varies by location so call first)

- Unused prescription and over-the-counter medicine (preferably left in original container)



Food Lion

- Plastic bags and plastic film (i.e. sandwich bags, air pillows, dry cleaning bags, produce bags, etc.)
- Cardboard



Kohls

- Plastic bags

Lowe's (home improvement store)

- Plastic bags
- Rechargeable batteries
- CFL and fluorescent light bulbs



Lowe's (foods)

- Plastic bags
- Paper



Office Depot

- Ink cartridges

Pets Inc. (300 Orchard Dr., West Columbia)

- Empty pill bottles, labels removed



Publix

- Paper at some (e.g. Hendrix Crossing)
- Plastic bags and plastic film (i.e. sandwich bags, air pillows, dry cleaning bags, produce bags, etc.)
- Styrofoam

Target

- Aluminum cans
- Ink cartridges
- Plastic bags
- Small Electronics (cell phones, MP3 players)



Wal-Mart

- Plastic bags and plastic film (i.e. clear, stretchy plastic such as air pillows, etc.)
