PLANNING and ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE MINUTES OCTOBER 14, 2008

The Planning and Administration Committee met on Tuesday, October 14, 2008 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 3:50 p.m. Mr. Jeffcoat, Committee Chairman presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

Residential Occupancy Limitations (Goal 2) - Planning and GIS - Charlie Compton, Director -

Mr. Compton presented options for residential occupancy limitations. The following three options were recommended: First Option – amend Group Housing definition, Second Option – more detailed amendment of Group Housing definition, and Third Option – create a new section, presented at the last meeting, with changes made to the numeric criteria so that the maximum occupancy will be much larger. The change was from "no greater than either the total of four persons per bedroom or one person per 50 square feet of bedroom space, depending on which quantity is the smallest" to "no greater than either the total of five persons per bedroom space, depending on which quantity is the smallest" to "no greater than either the total of five persons per bedroom space, depending on which quantity is the smallest." The Committee discussed the issues of enforcing the proposed changes for group housing and limitations. Staff requested to define dormitory fashion. For information only, no action taken.

Approval of Minutes - Meeting of September 23, 2008 – A motion was made by Mr. Banning, seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the September 23, 2008 minutes as submitted.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Old Business/New Business - Land Use Growth, Landscape Ordinance - None.
