## <u>Lexington County SC Commercial Building Permit Submittal Requirements</u>

- ·Complete Commercial Building Permit Application create your project through www.BluePrinceportal.com and upload all required documentation & licensure.
- · Provide two sets of Hard Copy plans; one for building review + one for Fire review
- ·One set of digital plans (pdf) may be emailed to buildinginspections@lexingtoncounty.sc.gov –submit thumb drive with hard copy sets or upload plans through www.BluePrinceportal.com .
- ·Plan Review Fee payment in the form of check made payable to "County of Lexington" Receipt will be emailed when project has been created by Development Assistant, Ms. Megan Blakely
- $\cdot$ Plan Review Fees as of July  $1_{st}$ , 2025 are: If the project is less than 1 million, fees are \$295.00. If the project is 1 million or more, fees are \$575.00.
- ·Plan review may take up to three weeks.
- ·All Sub-Contractor information for Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing must be submitted before the Commercial Master Permit may be issued. Each Sub must complete a Sub-Contractor Permit Application (see attached) with a copy of their SC LLR Contractors License and copy of the license holders ID.
- ·To Be Determined Submittals plan review may be conducted without a GC, HOWEVER, a permit will not be generated until the General Contractor of record submits an application with SC LLR & ID. · Zoning, Landscape, & Land Division permits may also be required for your proposed project.
