Federal Notice PL 114-113



- Published June 17th
- Effective Date June 22nd
- Total of \$299,000,000 awarded in SC & TX
- Plus \$1,000,000 for HUD TA and Planning
- Provides \$16,332,000 to Lexington County

Federal Regulations



- Eligible Activities
- 70% Low-Income Set-Aside
- Maximum of 5% of funds for Program Administration
- Maximum of 15% of funds for Planning
- Serves Unmet Needs (remaining storm damage)
- Recovery & Resiliency Measures
- Citizen Participation
- Record Keeping & Reporting

Flood Vulnerability Index

- ① Flood Way Location
- ② Floor Elevation Below the 100 Year Base Flood Elevation
- ③ Percent of Damage from October Storm Event
- ④ Historical Flood Claims (Number of Incidents)
- ⑤ Household Income

Buy-outs (cont.)



- Pre-storm Value
- Less Duplication of Benefits
- Firm Offer – no Negotiations
- Voluntary
- Moving Assistance
- Purchase Assistance

\$150,000 Pre-storm Value

- \$50,000 in previous benefits

\$100,000 Buy-out Purchase Price

+ \$ 5,000 Moving Expenses

+ \$ 10,000 Purchase Assistance

\$115,000 Total Payment

Housing Rehabilitation



- Owner Occupied
 - Health & Safety Issues will receive Priority Assistance
- Residential Property in Lexington County
- Minor Rehab up to \$45,000, or 49% value of home, in work required whichever is less
 - Roof Replacement
 - Mold Remediation
 - Exterior Repairs

- Public Comment Period
 - (August 29 – September 12)
- *Action Plan* due to HUD by September 20th
- Work begins in November
