

🖧 At The Edmund Landfill



Lexington County residents may bring up to five (5) electronics at no charge from their primary residence to be recycled. Businesses may also bring up to five (5) with a fee of \$.15/lb. Stop on the scale at the landfill for instructions and be prepared to unload all items yourself. The Edmund Landfill is located at 429 Landfill Ln, Lexington, SC 29073 and is open Monday-Saturday 7am-4:30pm. Closed on Sundays.

Recycling Drop-Off Opportunities

Lexington County residents may bring up to five (5) electronics to Recycling Drop-Off Opportunities with our Household Hazardous Waste partner, Republic Services (*As opportunities are available*). Go to <u>https://lex-co.sc.gov/dept-swm</u> for the schedule and a list of accepted materials, or contact Solid Waste Management @ <u>recycling@lex-co.com</u> to receive email notifications prior to each Drop-Off Opportunity. (Materials from businesses, schools and churches are <u>not</u> accepted.)

Things to Know:

- Computer components are bundled to count as one and a box or bag of small items (e.g. cell phones) count as one.
- Computers, computer monitors, printers and TVs are <u>only</u> accepted by Lexington County at the Edmund Landfill or at Recycling Drop-off Opportunities.
- Other, smaller, electronics may be recycled in the "scrap metal" containers (if mostly metal) at any of the 11 Collection and Recycling Centers or may be disposed of in household garbage (if mostly plastic).

🖧 At Local Stores

Check with your local retailers (such as Best Buy or Staples) to see if they take part in an electronics recycling program and what they accept.

🖧 Charitable Groups 🖉

Donate Working electronics to charitable organizations such as His House (803) 791-0557, (Pick-up service provided), or Goodwill Industries. CRT (Box-style) TVs are **not** accepted by these organizations.
