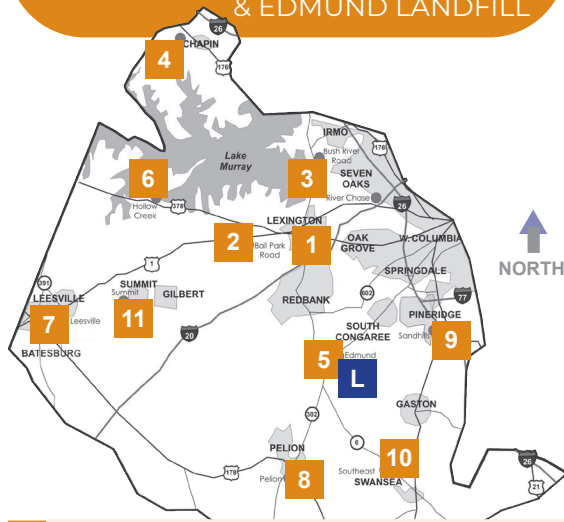

7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; Sunday, 3 p.m. to 7 p.m.

NOTES: Collection & Recycling Centers are for Lexington County residents only and are intended for household garbage and recyclables generated at the resident's home. Business-generated waste and recyclables must be taken to the Edmund Landfill.

EDMUND LANDFILL HOURS: OPEN Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

CURBSIDE SERVICES: County residents in the unincorporated areas (i.e., outside town limits) can sign up for service by contacting their designated hauler.

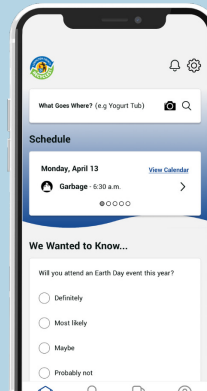
- **BACKYARD COMPOST BIN KITS** are available for purchase at the Edmund Landfill. Please call **(803) 785-3325** for more information.
- **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) DROP-OFF EVENTS:** Lexington County holds special events to collect HHW (e.g., pesticides, paint, cleaners) from residents.

HOW TO RECYCLE RIGHT

- **Recycle loose, not bagged!** Place recyclable items directly into the recycling container. **DO NOT bag them.** Plastic bags can jam sorting equipment and prevent materials from being properly sorted and recycled.
- **Empty and rinse** all containers.
- **Items less than 2 X 2 inches ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
- **Labels** do not need to be removed from glass, plastic or metal.
- **For plastic containers,** if the top screws on, leave it on. If it pops off, take it off (and discard it).
- **Paper items** (e.g., cardboard, newspaper) should be kept dry.

IN CURBSIDE BINS

- **Only include** 1) **plastic containers,** 2) **metal cans,** 3) **paper and cardboard,** and 4) **glass bottles and jars** (if allowed in your area).
- **Flatten** cardboard and cartons, but do not flatten cans and bottles.
- **DO NOT include** long, thin materials (e.g., hangers, cords), scrap metal, or hazardous material.
- **When in doubt,** leave it out ... or ask! Email recycling@lexingtoncounty.sc.gov or get the **Lexington County Solid Waste** app!

YOU SHOULD KNOW

- **Household garbage** is accepted at all Collection & Recycling Centers and Edmund Landfill.
- Lexington County residents may dispose of **large appliances** at the Edmund Landfill. Large appliances also can be collected through curbside service for an additional fee.

VEHICLE FLUIDS (e.g., gear oil, diesel fuel, fuel oil, gasoline, kerosene, motor oil, antifreeze) Brake fluid is only accepted at our HHW and recycling drop-off events.	No	YES	YES	No	No
WOOD WASTE, CLEAN (e.g., branches, stumps, pallets, leaves, pine straw, pine cones, Christmas trees) is accepted at Augusta Road, Ball Park, Bush River, Chapin, Edmund, and Sandhills centers.	No	SOME	YES	No	No

- ◆ Loads with more than four tires and commercially generated tires are accepted ONLY at the Edmund Landfill. A handling fee will be assessed unless business shows valid ST-390.
- Participating grocery stores will take egg cartons ONLY.
- Edmund Landfill solid waste fees may apply.
- ✦ Keep Midlands Beautiful shredding events for Lexington County residents only.
