HOW TO GET SPECIALIZED PHONE EQUIPMENT FREE

This is through the South Carolina Equipment Distribution Program (SCEDP). You must be a legal, permanent resident of South Carolina, have a home phone (not a cell phone), and have a qualifying disability confirmed by one of the following professional certifiers: audiologist, physician, physician's assistant, advanced practice registered nurse, speech-language pathologist, or hearing aid specialist. If you are eligible, you'll get phone equipment absolutely free for as long as you need it. You will need to complete a one-page application, which you can pick up from our office.
